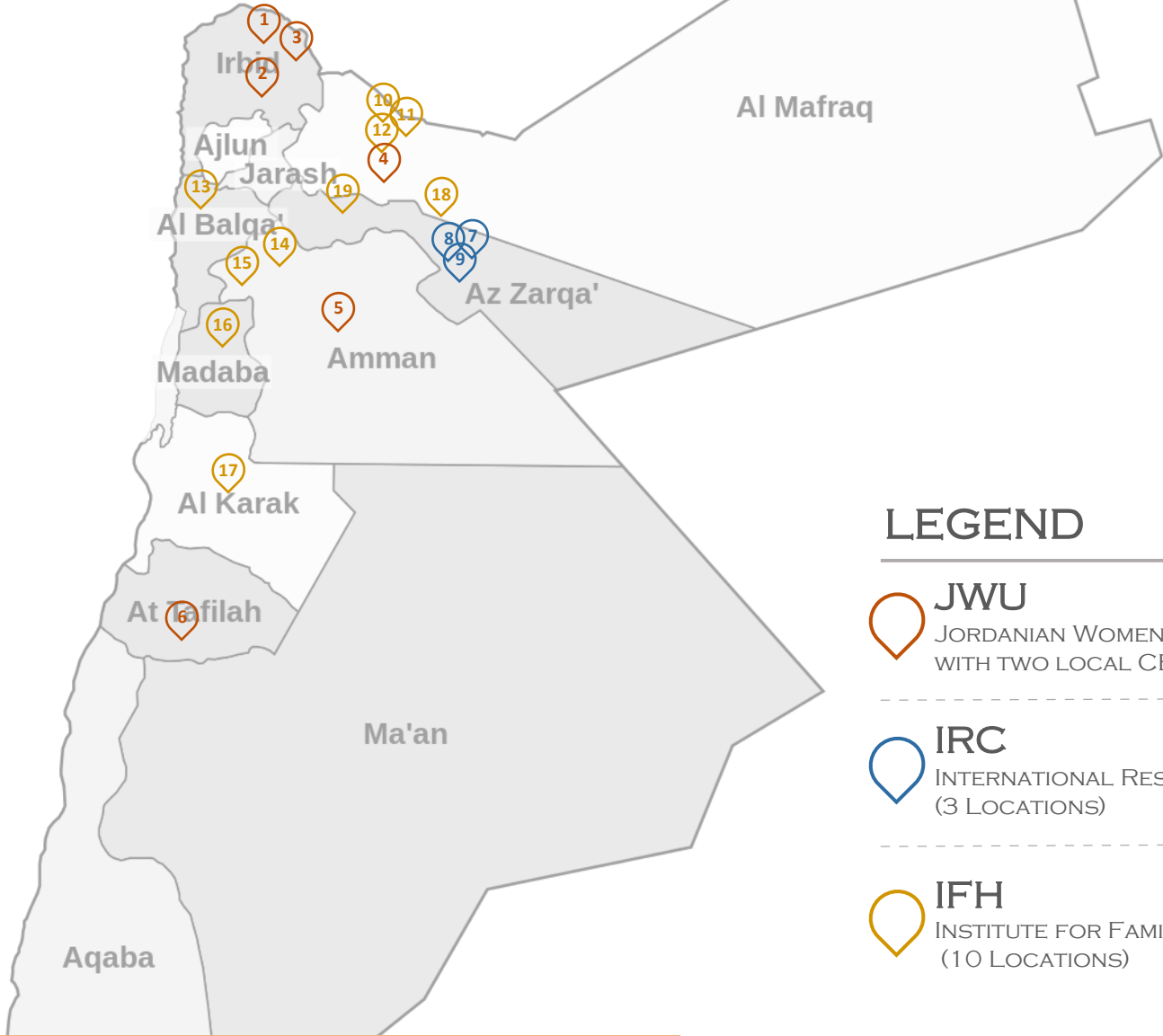


UNFPA SUPPORTED WOMEN AND GIRLS SAFE SPACES

BACKGROUND

UNFPA works in partnership with civil society organizations through women and girls safe spaces across the Kingdom. In the Women and Girls Safe spaces, women and girls can access non-stigmatizing GBV response and prevention services including access to case management services, referrals, psychosocial support, awareness raising, counselling, life skills and empowerment activities. Those programmes have a component of disability inclusion to ensure no one is left behind. In 2020 with 3 partners Institute for Family Health (IFH), Jordanian Women Union (JWU) and the International Rescue Committee (IRC) and two local CBOs, UNFPA extended support to women and girls and communities with 19 centers as per map.
